

A committee of nine members has been constituted to oversee child safety and protection initiatives. All teachers and staff are made aware of the relevant Acts and their responsibilities to protect children from any form of abuse.

Gender sensitization workshops are conducted for all teachers. Regular counselling and guidance sessions are provided for both teachers and students to promote mental well-being and awareness.

A harmonious and inclusive environment is ensured throughout the institution. Girls receive training in self-defence and self-protection techniques such as karate.

Regular interactions between POCSO (Protection of Children from Sexual Offences) Committee members and students are organized to build trust and awareness.

CCTV cameras are installed and monitored regularly to prevent any kind of mishap. During trips or excursions, students are always accompanied by both a male and a female teacher, as per the requirement.

Regular meetings are conducted. If there are any concerns or updates—based on news or newspaper reports—extra care or protective measures are implemented accordingly.

Police verification is conducted for all employees. Access to the school building is controlled and monitored to prevent unauthorized entry. A visitor logbook is maintained where visitors are required to enter the purpose of their visit and other relevant details.
